


Box - Intermediate Puzzle #4



This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a 3D block and can be a part of a "word" in the X,Y, and Z directions.

Rules:

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" in the X direction read from left to right.
- 3. "Words" in the Y direction read from top to bottom.
- 4. "Words" in the Z direction read from front to back.
- 5. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 6. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.

If we take the box pictured above and divide it into individual X-Y layers, we will get these planes:

X Direction

- 1 Seven times a square
- 4 Twice Y12
- 6 X19 minus half of X10
- **8** Three times a prime number
- **10** Last two digits are the same as X4
- 13 Mean of Z9 and Y18
- **14** Twice the result of Z1 plus Y3
- **16** Rearranged digits of X19
- **19** Four times a prime number

Y Direction

- **2** Thirty-three times a prime number
- 3 Same as Z3
- **6** A square
- **10** A square
- **11** Twelve times a prime number
- **12** A prime number
- **17** X14 minus Z9
- **18** Five times a prime number

Z Direction

- 1 Fifteen times a prime number
- **2** A square
- 3 Same as X6
- 4 X16 minus Z5
- **5** A prime number
- 7 Mean of Y6 and X8
- **8** Forty-five times a prime number
- **9** A square
- **15** Twice a prime number
