


Cross Figure - Beginner Puzzle #50

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 9 down plus half of 2 down
- Thirteen times a prime number
- 5 down divided by eleven
- Half of 7 down, then subtract 5 down
- 10 across minus half of 11 down
- Two-thirds of 12 down
- Six times a square
- Thirty-five times a square

Down

- Twice a prime number
- Mean of 7 down and 8 across
- A prime number
- Eleven times a prime number
- Thirty-two times 10 across
- Three times a prime number
- Four times a prime number
- 1 down minus 5 across
