


# **CrossFigure - Challenging Puzzle #1**

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

### **Rules:**

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- 3. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 4. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



#### **Across**

- **3** A square
- **4** Mean of 21 across and 18 across
- **5** Mean of 13 down and 9 across
- **6** Four times 19 across
- 7 Three-fifths of 4 across
- **9** Three-fourths of 3 across
- **10** 13 across plus 19 across
- 13 8 down minus 16 down
- **15** A square
- **17** 3 across minus 15 across
- 18 10 across minus 17 across
- 19 13 down minus 17 across
- 20 Last two digits are the same as 18 across
- **21** Four times 11 down

#### **Down**

- 1 Fifty-five times a prime number
- 2 1 down minus 6 across
- **5** 9 across reversed
- 8 Mean of 15 across and 13 down
- **11** 7 across minus 12 down
- 12 15 across minus 18 across
- **13** 12 down plus 16 down
- **14** 20 across times 19 across
- **15** A prime number
- **16** 3 across minus 6 across
