


CrossFigure - Challenging Puzzle #5

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- 3. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 4. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 1 Mean of 19 across and 16 across
- 3 1 across minus 9 down
- **4** Five times a prime number
- **5** All digits are the same
- **6** A square
- **9** Mean of 6 down and 3 across
- **12** Twenty-one times a prime number
- **14** 15 down divided by 4 across
- **16** 9 down reversed
- 17 Mean of 8 down and 9 down
- 18 17 across plus 9 down
- **19** Twice a prime number

Down

- 2 Mean of 3 down and 17 across
- **3** Sixty times 5 across
- **6** Last two digits are the same as 4 across
- **7** Three times a prime number
- **8** 18 across minus half of 5 across
- 9 16 across reversed
- **10** A prime number
- 11 Mean of 14 across and 10 down
- 13 Mean of 12 across and 11 down
- 15 Ninety-five times a prime number
