


CrossFigure - Challenging Puzzle #14

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- 3. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 4. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 1 Mean of 5 down and 1 down
- **2** A square
- 3 Mean of 2 across and 5 down
- **7** 10 across times 3 across
- 10 23 across plus 19 down
- **12** 13 across plus 10 down
- 13 23 across minus 13 down
- 15 18 across divided by 21 down
- **16** 14 down minus 6 down
- 17 Half of 16 across, then subtract 20 down
- **18** 15 across times 24 across
- **22** 11 down minus 19 down
- **23** 16 across minus 1 across
- 24 Twice the result of 23 across plus 1 across

Down

- 1 12 across minus 4 down
- 4 12 across minus 22 across
- 5 Mean of 13 down and 1 across
- **6** 7 across divided by 10 across
- 8 One thousand three hundred two more than 18 across
- **9** Twelve times a prime number
- **10** 15 across minus 5 down
- 11 18 down minus 17 across
- 13 15 across minus 14 down
- 14 18 down plus half of 13 across
- **18** 24 across minus 1 across
- 19 Mean of 4 down and 20 down
- 20 23 across minus 13 across
- 21 Six times 1 down
