


CrossFigure - Challenging Puzzle #29

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- 3. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 4. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 2 One hundred ninety more than 18 across
- **4** 3 down minus 10 down
- 6 3 down minus 15 across
- **7** 6 down plus 13 across
- **13** 6 across plus 17 down
- **15** 3 down minus 14 down
- 16 Mean of 13 across and 1 down
- 18 9 down times 12 down

Down

- **1** A cube
- **3** 7 across plus 10 down
- **5** 6 down plus half of 15 down
- **6** 1 down minus 14 down
- 8 Twice the result of 6 across plus 14 down
- **9** Five times 6 down
- 10 12 down minus 15 across
- 11 2 across divided by 15 across
- **12** Five times a square
- 14 13 across minus 17 down
- 15 Mean of 4 across and 15 across
- 17 7 across reversed
