


CrossFigure - Challenging Puzzle #32

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- 3. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 4. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- **2** A prime number
- **5** Half of 18 across, then subtract 14 down
- **6** Two hundred less than 3 down
- **7** Thirty-one times a prime number
- **11** Consecutive digits in descending order
- **13** Half of 1 down, then subtract 17 down
- **15** Thirty-nine times a prime number
- 18 Ninety times a prime number
- **19** Twice a prime number
- 20 15 across plus half of 2 down

Down

- **1** Fourteen times a prime number
- **2** Twice a prime number
- **3** 2 across minus half of 10 down
- 4 8 down minus half of 19 across
- 8 Sixty-six times a prime number
- **9** 7 across minus 12 down
- 10 5 across divided by five
- 12 Three times a prime number
- **14** Fifteen times a prime number
- **15** 6 across minus half of 16 down
- **16** Fifteen times 13 across
- **17** A prime number
