

CrossFigure - Challenging Puzzle #37

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- 3. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 4. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 5 3 down minus 14 down
- **7** Forty-six times a prime number
- **9** 7 across minus half of 11 across
- **10** A prime number
- **11** Five times a square
- 15 14 down plus half of 16 down

Down

- 1 8 down divided by twenty-one
- **2** All digits are the same
- **3** Mean of 8 down and 4 down
- **4** Twice 10 across
- **6** Eight times a prime number
- 7 12 down minus 2 down 12 Five times a prime number
- **13** Mean of 5 across and 1 down
- **14** Mean of 16 down and 9 across
- 16 13 down minus 15 across
