


CrossFigure - Intermediate Puzzle #2

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- 3. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 4. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- **1** Eleven times 3 down
- **3** A prime number
- 4 Six times a prime number
- **6** Mean of 8 across and 7 across
- **7** Two-fifths of 11 down
- **8** Twice the result of 9 across minus 7 across
- **9** A prime number
- **10** 5 down divided by 6 across
- **12** 3 across plus half of 1 across
- **13** 4 across minus 10 down

Down

- 2 3 down reversed
- 3 2 down reversed
- **5** Fifty-two times a prime number
- **10** A square
- **11** Five times a prime number
