
Difficulty:

CrossFigure - Intermediate Puzzle #19

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- 3. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 4. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 1 Mean of 14 across and 7 down
- 6 One thousand sixty-six more than 1 across
- **7** Twice a prime number
- 8 Sum of digits in 12 down
- **10** Twenty-five less than 7 down
- 11 Mean of 15 down and 3 down
- **13** Twice the result of 9 down minus 10 across
- **14** Forty-four times a prime number
- **18** Twice the result of 6 across plus 17 down

Down

- **1** Fourteen times a square
- **2** A prime number
- **3** Ten times a square
- 4 Seven times a square
- **5** Nine times 11 across
- 7 Sixteen times a prime number
- **9** Twenty-six times a prime number
- **12** Five times a prime number
- **13** Twice the result of 1 down minus 7 across
- **15** Three times a square
- **16** 13 across plus 11 across
- 17 Mean of 7 across and 13 across
