


CrossFigure - Intermediate Puzzle #20

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- 3. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 4. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 1 Seven thousand six hundred eighty-nine less than 6 across
- **5** Four times a prime number
- **6** A prime number
- **8** 14 across divided by nineteen
- **9** A prime number
- 10 One thousand eight hundred fifty-eight more than 15 across 11 Mean of 4 down and 2 down
- **14** Nineteen times a prime number

Down

- 2 15 across divided by 7 down
- **3** 11 down plus 8 across
- **4** 1 across divided by 9 across
- **6** A prime number
- **7** Eleven times a square
- 12 Consecutive digits unordered
- 13 5 across minus 12 down
