


# **CrossFigure - Intermediate Puzzle #23**

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

#### **Rules:**

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- 3. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 4. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



### **Across**

- **1** 9 across plus 11 across
- **2** Mean of 1 across and 10 across
- **5** Eleven times a square
- 7 Consecutive digits in descending order
- **8** Twice the result of 10 across minus 7 across
- **9** Twice a square
- **10** A cube
- 11 Three times 10 across

### Down

- **3** First two digits are the same as 7 across
- 4 3 down divided by 2 across
- **6** Three-fifths of 5 across
