This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

### Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.

### Across

- Fifty-five times a square
- Consecutive digits in ascending order
- Consecutive digits in descending order
- Twice the result of 9 down plus 9 across
- A square
- 11 down times 12 across
- 6 down divided by 3 down
- Mean of 8 down and 11 across
- Ten more than 15 across
- 13 down minus 16 across
- Half of 2 across, then subtract 4 across

### Down

- Forty-one less than 8 down
- Two hundred fifteen less than 2 across
- Thirty-two times a prime number
- Twenty-seven times a prime number
- All digits are the same
- Seven times a prime number
- 1 down plus 14 across
