
Difficulty:

CrossFigure - Intermediate Puzzle #35

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- 3. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 4. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- **3** 9 down divided by four
- **5** 9 down minus 8 across
- **6** 7 down times 5 down
- **7** Three times a prime number
- **8** A prime number

Down

- **1** 4 down minus 2 down
- **2** Consecutive digits in ascending order
- **4** Forty-five times 7 across
- **5** Nineteen times a prime number
- 7 A square
- **9** Four more than 7 down
