


CrossFigure - Intermediate Puzzle #36

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- 3. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 4. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 2 Consecutive digits in ascending order
- 3 8 across minus 4 down
- **4** Five times a prime number
- **6** Mean of 5 down and 2 across
- **7** Forty-two times a square
- **8** Eighty-nine times 10 across
- **10** Half of 7 across, then subtract 1 down
- 11 Twice the result of 9 down minus 4 across

Down

- **1** 4 across divided by five
- 4 Sixty-seven less than 4 across
- **5** Fifty-three times 10 across
- **9** Fourteen times a prime number
