
Difficulty:

CrossFigure - Intermediate Puzzle #45

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- 3. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 4. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- **1** Twice the result of 5 down plus 14 down
- **6** A prime number
- 9 Mean of 11 across and 2 down
- 10 Three-fifths of 3 down
- **11** 13 across reversed
- 12 Consecutive digits in ascending order
- **13** 11 across reversed
- 16 4 down minus 13 across

Down

- **2** Three times 15 down
- **3** 7 down minus 6 across
- 4 Four thousand six hundred fifty-six more than 5 down
- **5** Seven times a prime number
- **7** Four times a prime number
- 8 Twice a prime number
- **9** Twice a prime number
- **14** A prime number
- **15** Sum of digits in 8 down
