
Difficulty:

CrossFigure - Intermediate Puzzle #46

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- 3. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 4. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- **1** 6 down divided by 2 across
- **2** Seven times 17 across
- **4** Three times 17 across
- 5 Forty-seven times a square
- **7** 16 across divided by 13 across
- 9 Mean of 7 across and 12 across
- 10 Mean of 4 across and 9 across
- **12** A prime number
- **13** Mean of 11 down and 10 across
- **14** 15 down minus 19 across
- **16** Sixty-eight times a prime number
- **17** 7 across reversed
- **18** A square
- **19** 14 across minus 18 across

Down

- **2** Twenty-one times a prime number
- **3** 9 across plus half of 11 down
- **6** Thirteen times a square
- 8 Half of 5 across, then subtract 4 across
- 9 Twice the result of 17 across plus 18 across
- **11** 3 down minus 17 across
- **14** Forty-seven times 17 across
- **15** 10 across plus 9 down
