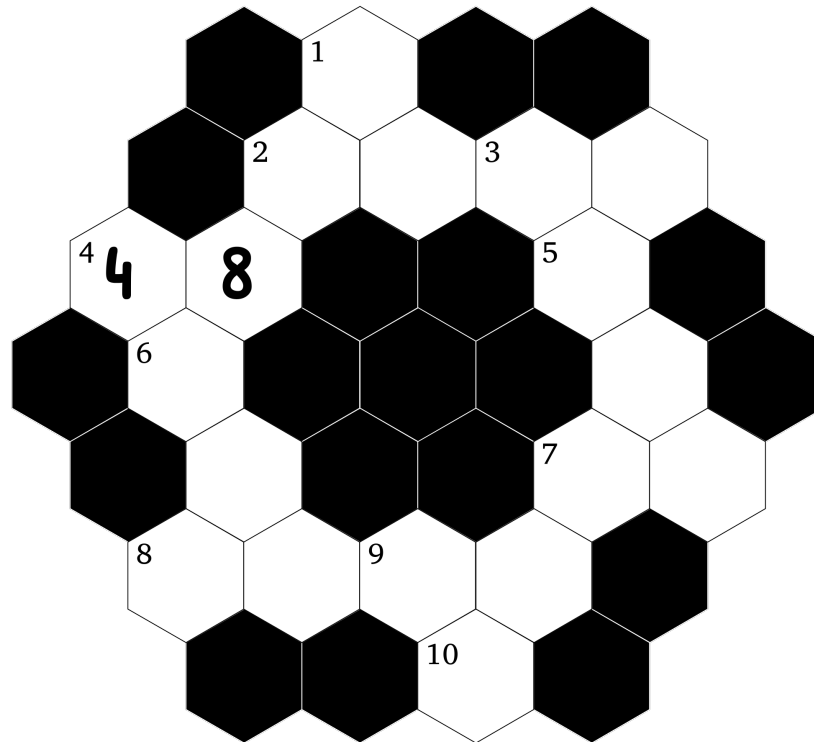
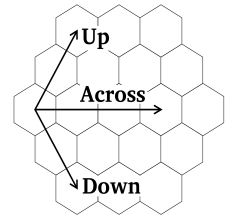


TripleCross - Beginner Puzzle #2

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a hexagonal cell and can be a part of a "word" in the across, up, and down directions.

Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" in the 'across' direction read from left to right.
- "Words" in the 'up' direction read along the upward diagonal to the right.
- "Words" in the 'down' direction read along the downward diagonal to the right.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 2 One hundred fifty-six less than 4 down
- 4 Three-fifths of 7 across
- 7 Five times a square
- 8 Twice a prime number

Up

- 5 Consecutive digits in ascending order
- 6 Thirty-nine times a prime number
- 8 Half of 2 across, then subtract 8 across
- 10 6 up plus half of 1 down

Down

- 1 Ten times a prime number
- 3 Twice the result of 4 down minus 7 across
- 4 Eighty times a prime number
- 9 Half of 8 up
