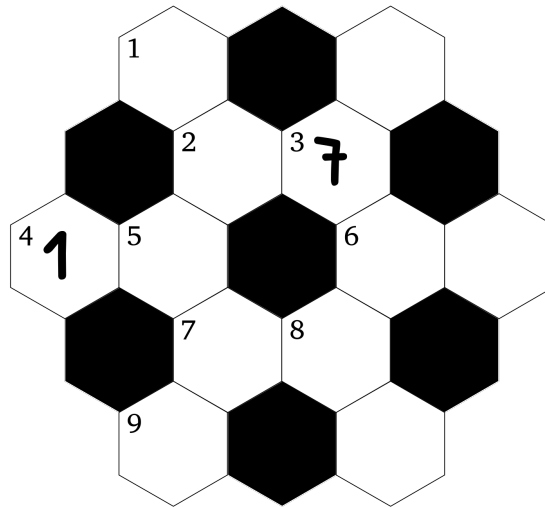
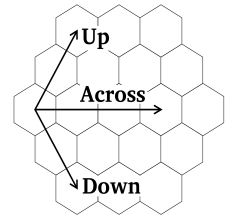


TripleCross - Beginner Puzzle #4

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a hexagonal cell and can be a part of a "word" in the across, up, and down directions.

Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" in the 'across' direction read from left to right.
- "Words" in the 'up' direction read along the upward diagonal to the right.
- "Words" in the 'down' direction read along the downward diagonal to the right.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 2 A cube
- 4 Half of 5 up, then subtract 9 up
- 6 Half of 7 across, then subtract 8 down
- 7 3 down plus 8 up

Up

- 3 Twice the result of 1 down plus 2 across
- 5 Six times 1 down
- 8 1 down reversed
- 9 Mean of 4 across and 8 up

Down

- 1 8 down minus 6 across
- 3 4 across reversed
- 5 A prime number
- 8 4 across plus 1 down
