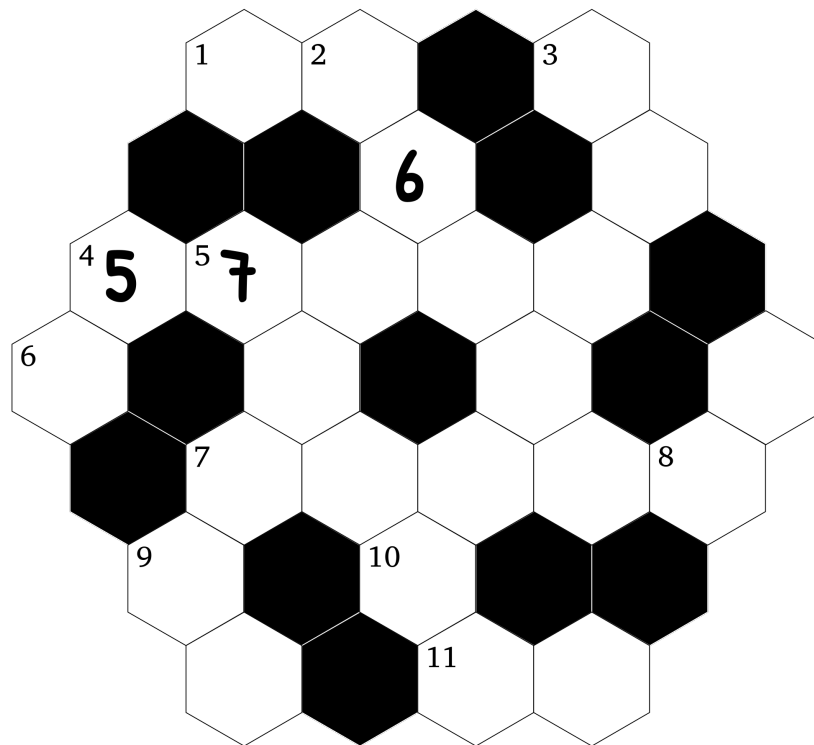
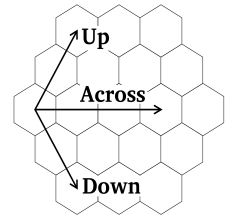


# TripleCross - Beginner Puzzle #10

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a hexagonal cell and can be a part of a "word" in the across, up, and down directions.

## Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" in the 'across' direction read from left to right.
- "Words" in the 'up' direction read along the upward diagonal to the right.
- "Words" in the 'down' direction read along the downward diagonal to the right.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



### Across

- 1 6 up minus half of 8 up
- 4 Mean of 10 up and 5 down
- 7 Five times a prime number
- 11 Two-thirds of 3 down

### Up

- 6 Consecutive digits in descending order
- 8 Consecutive digits in ascending order
- 9 Fourteen times a prime number

### Down

- 2 Four thousand eight hundred seventy-five more than 5 down
- 3 Consecutive digits in descending order
- 5 Five times a prime number
- 9 7 across minus 9 up
