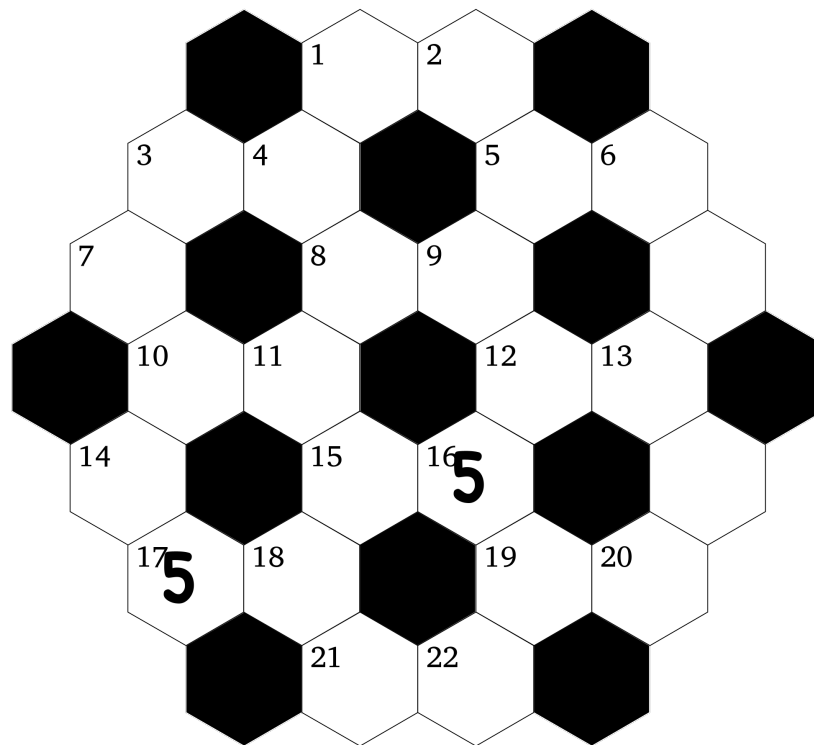
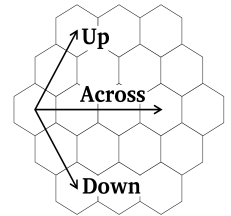


TripleCross - Beginner Puzzle #12

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a hexagonal cell and can be a part of a "word" in the across, up, and down directions.

Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" in the 'across' direction read from left to right.
- "Words" in the 'up' direction read along the upward diagonal to the right.
- "Words" in the 'down' direction read along the downward diagonal to the right.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- Twice the result of 13 down plus 22 up
- Mean of 2 down and 7 down
- Mean of 2 down and 9 up
- 22 up plus 13 down
- A square
- Mean of 7 up and 14 up
- 9 down plus 18 up
- Mean of 2 down and 19 across
- A square
- 18 down plus 15 across

Up

- Mean of 15 across and 17 across
- Mean of 12 across and 3 across
- 14 down minus 9 down
- Twice the result of 11 down minus 10 across
- 10 across minus 22 up
- 9 down reversed
- 13 down plus 9 up
- A square
- Mean of 4 up and 6 down
- 14 up minus 20 up

Down

- 18 down plus 6 down
- Mean of 14 down and 13 down
- Mean of 3 across and 16 down
- 18 down plus 5 across
- A square
- 21 across plus 13 down
- 15 across divided by five
- Mean of 11 down and 14 up
- Mean of 4 up and 8 across
- Half of 6 down, then subtract 18 up
