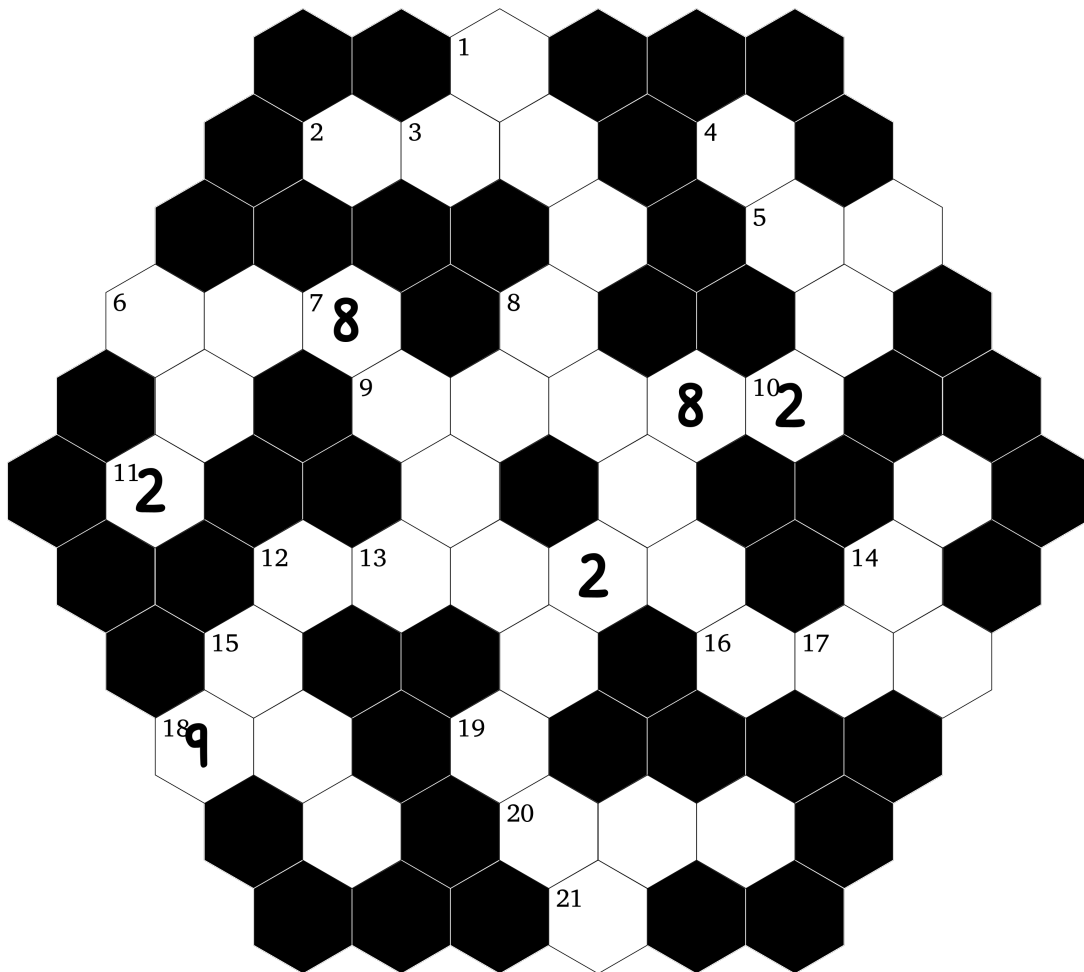
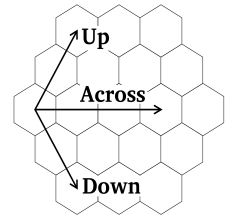


TripleCross - Beginner Puzzle #14

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a hexagonal cell and can be a part of a "word" in the across, up, and down directions.

Rules:

1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
2. "Words" in the 'across' direction read from left to right.
3. "Words" in the 'up' direction read along the upward diagonal to the right.
4. "Words" in the 'down' direction read along the downward diagonal to the right.
5. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
6. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 2 Eight times a prime number
- 5 A square
- 6 Three-fourths of 2 across
- 9 Sixty-two times a prime number
- 12 Mean of 7 down and 4 down
- 16 A cube
- 18 21 up plus 3 up
- 20 15 down minus 18 across

Up

- 3 A square
- 10 Six times a prime number
- 11 A square
- 13 Six times a prime number
- 17 Forty times a prime number
- 18 6 down plus 1 down
- 19 Twice a prime number
- 21 Half of 2 across, then subtract 16 across

Down

- 1 Twice the result of 10 up plus 11 up
- 4 Twice a prime number
- 6 17 up minus 6 across
- 7 Four times a prime number
- 8 9 across plus half of 19 up
- 14 3 up plus 5 across
- 15 Twenty-three times a prime number
- 19 Seven times 6 down
