

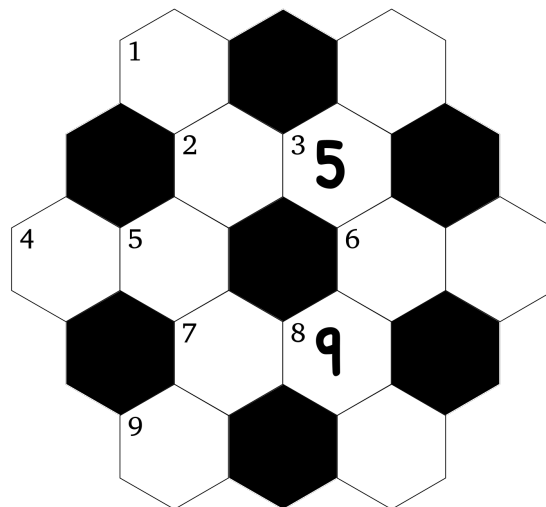
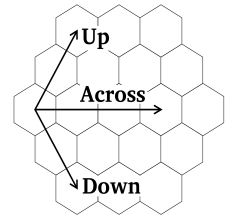

TripleCross - Beginner Puzzle #17

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a hexagonal cell and can be a part of a "word" in the across, up, and down directions.

Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" in the 'across' direction read from left to right.
- "Words" in the 'up' direction read along the upward diagonal to the right.
- "Words" in the 'down' direction read along the downward diagonal to the right.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 2 3 up reversed
- 4 8 up divided by seven
- 6 A prime number
- 7 Three times 5 up

Up

- 3 2 across reversed
- 5 Mean of 4 across and 3 up
- 8 Mean of 7 across and 1 down
- 9 3 down plus half of 8 down

Down

- 1 8 down minus 4 across
- 3 Mean of 6 across and 1 down
- 5 Three times 4 across
- 8 Five more than 8 up

Solution:
