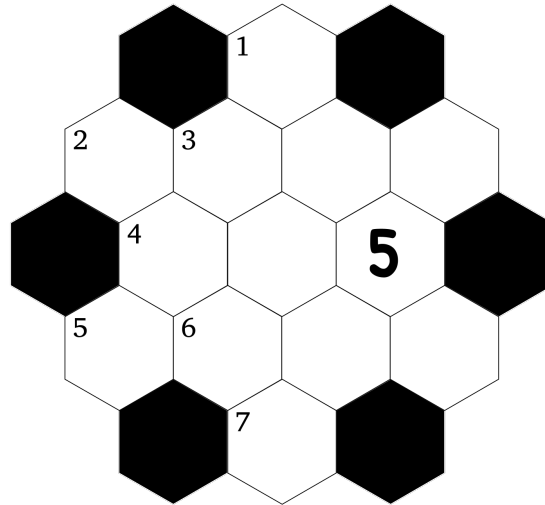
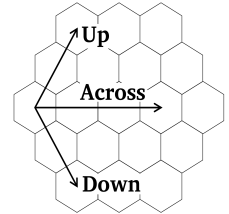


# TripleCross - Beginner Puzzle # 19

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a hexagonal cell and can be a part of a "word" in the across, up, and down directions.

**Rules:**

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" in the 'across' direction read from left to right.
- "Words" in the 'up' direction read along the upward diagonal to the right.
- "Words" in the 'down' direction read along the downward diagonal to the right.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



**Across**

- 2 Twice the result of 7 up minus 1 down
- 4 5 up minus 2 down
- 5 Twenty-seven times a prime number

**Up**

- 5 One thousand seven hundred fourteen more than 2 across
- 6 A prime number
- 7 Twice a prime number

**Down**

- 1 Eleven times a prime number
- 2 One thousand nine hundred thirty-nine more than 7 up
- 3 Ten times a prime number

Solution:
