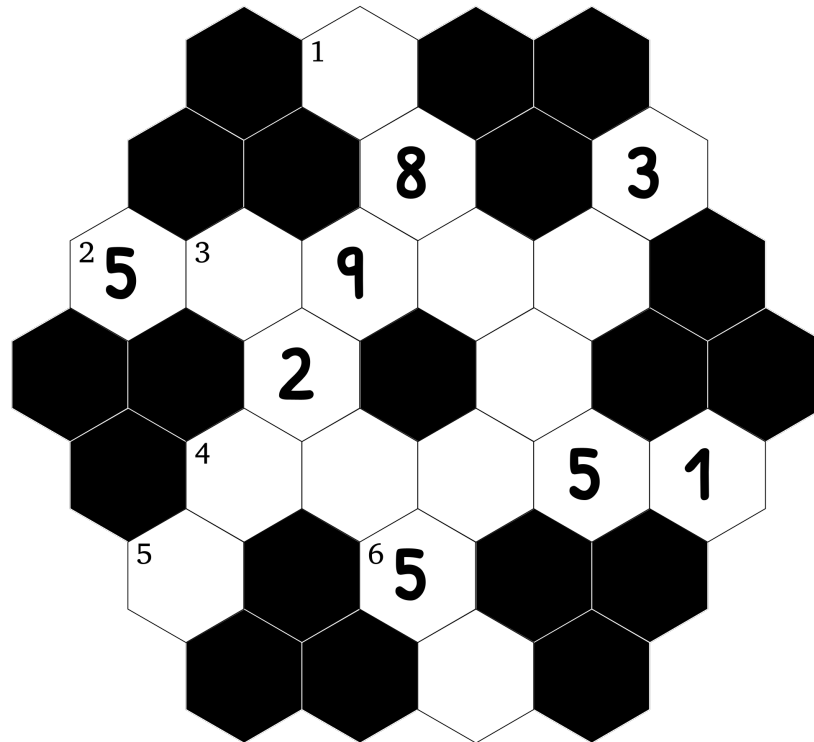
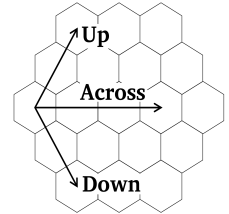


TripleCross - Beginner Puzzle #20

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a hexagonal cell and can be a part of a "word" in the across, up, and down directions.

Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" in the 'across' direction read from left to right.
- "Words" in the 'up' direction read along the upward diagonal to the right.
- "Words" in the 'down' direction read along the downward diagonal to the right.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 2 Twice a prime number
- 4 Seventeen thousand seven hundred fifty-three more than 5 up

Up

- 5 Seven thousand two hundred thirty-five more than 6 up
- 6 Thirteen times a prime number

Down

- 1 5 up minus half of 2 across
- 3 Mean of 6 up and 4 across
