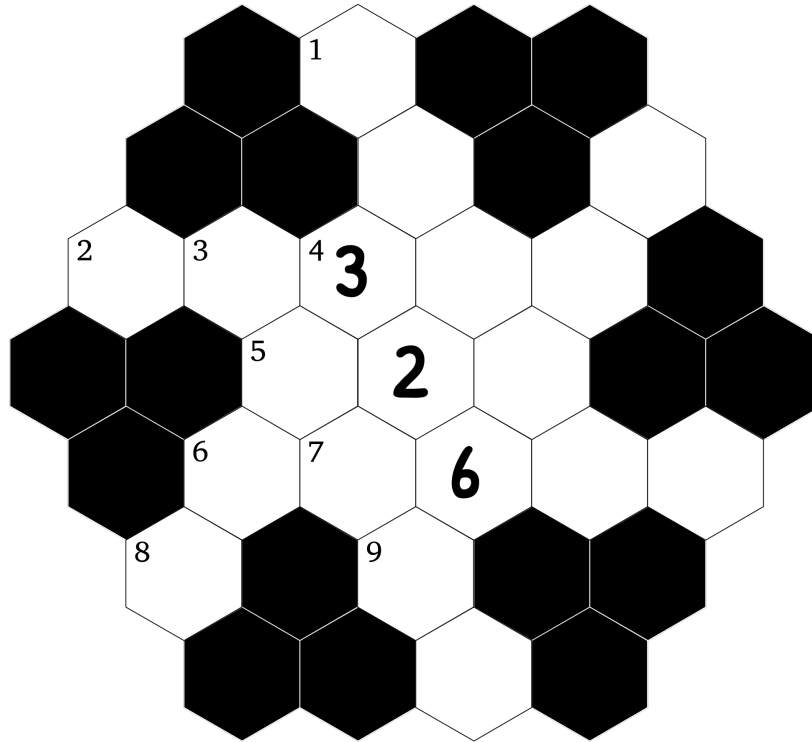
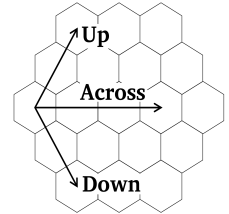


TripleCross - Beginner Puzzle #22

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a hexagonal cell and can be a part of a "word" in the across, up, and down directions.

Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" in the 'across' direction read from left to right.
- "Words" in the 'up' direction read along the upward diagonal to the right.
- "Words" in the 'down' direction read along the downward diagonal to the right.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 2 Four hundred nineteen less than 3 down
- 5 Forty times a prime number

Up

- 7 Four times a prime number
- 8 Twice the result of 6 across minus 7 up
- 9 1 down plus half of 2 across

Down

- 1 Sixty-one times a prime number
- 3 A prime number
- 4 Twice a prime number
