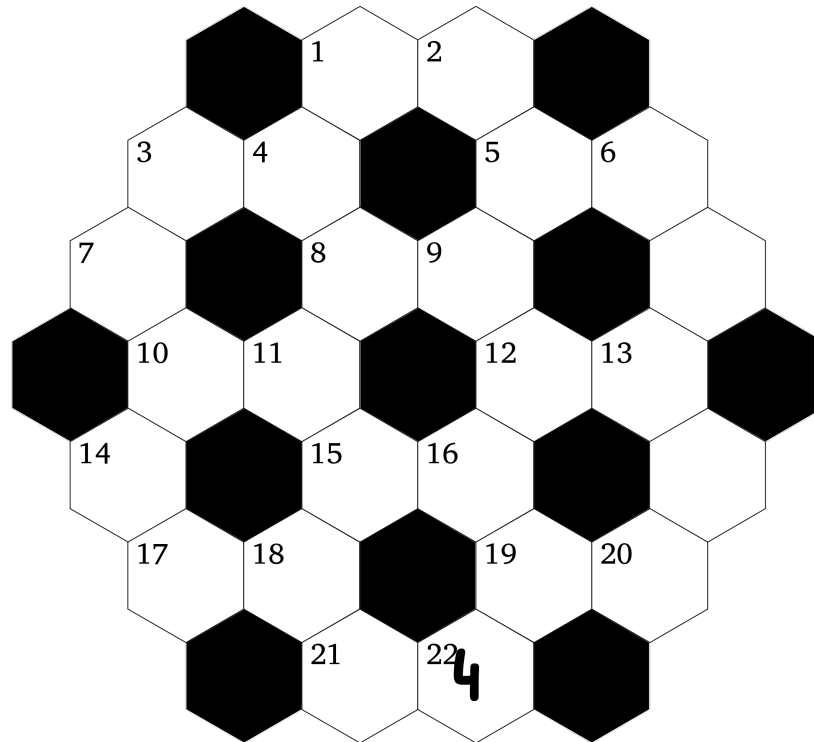
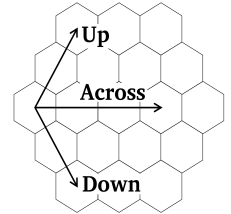


TripleCross - Beginner Puzzle #29

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a hexagonal cell and can be a part of a "word" in the across, up, and down directions.

Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" in the 'across' direction read from left to right.
- "Words" in the 'up' direction read along the upward diagonal to the right.
- "Words" in the 'down' direction read along the downward diagonal to the right.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 14 up minus 13 up
- Mean of 4 down and 13 up
- 2 down plus 3 across
- 19 across minus 2 down
- 13 up plus 11 down
- 14 up minus 6 down
- 14 up plus half of 2 down
- Mean of 8 across and 14 down
- 4 up plus 17 across
- Twice the result of 1 across minus 4 up

Up

- 5 across divided by three
- 5 across minus 13 down
- 10 across minus 16 up
- Mean of 19 across and 22 up
- A cube
- 6 down plus 7 up
- 13 up minus 4 down
- Same as 14 up
- 11 down divided by three
- Mean of 7 up and 21 across

Down

- 14 down minus 1 across
- 19 across minus 17 across
- Mean of 5 across and 11 down
- 21 across minus 5 across
- 2 down plus 8 across
- 9 up minus 4 up
- 7 down minus half of 16 up
- 15 across minus 4 down
- Half of 19 across, then subtract 20 up
- Mean of 10 across and 8 across
