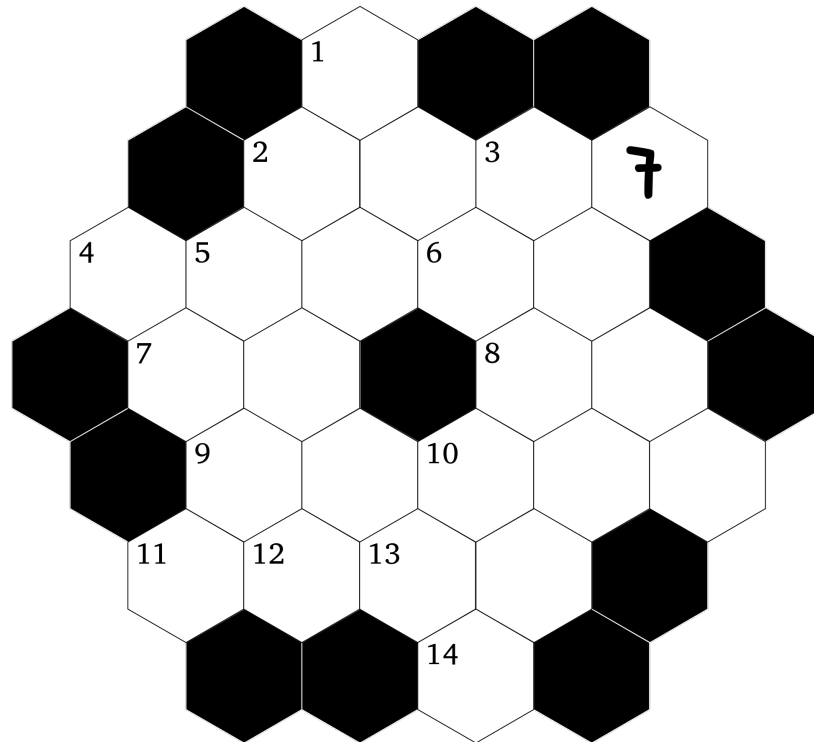
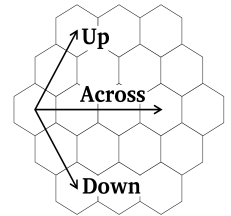


# TripleCross - Beginner Puzzle #35

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a hexagonal cell and can be a part of a "word" in the across, up, and down directions.

## Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" in the 'across' direction read from left to right.
- "Words" in the 'up' direction read along the upward diagonal to the right.
- "Words" in the 'down' direction read along the downward diagonal to the right.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



### Across

- 2 First two digits are the same as 2 down
- 4 Twice a prime number
- 7 Three times a prime number
- 8 Mean of 6 up and 7 across
- 9 Forty times a prime number
- 11 14 up minus 12 up

### Up

- 6 A prime number
- 7 Thirty-nine times a prime number
- 11 3 down plus 2 across
- 12 A prime number
- 13 Eleven times a prime number
- 14 Forty times a prime number

### Down

- 1 Twice the result of 13 up plus 4 down
- 2 A prime number
- 3 Nineteen times a square
- 4 A prime number
- 5 A prime number
- 10 A prime number
