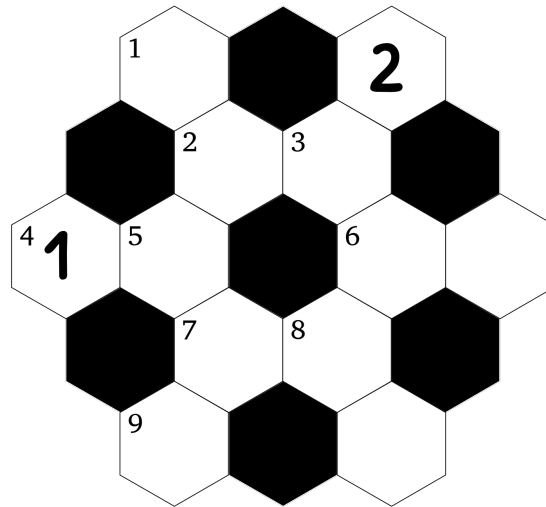
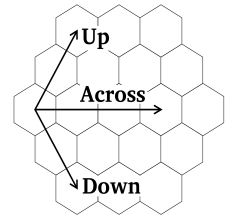


TripleCross - Beginner Puzzle #43

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a hexagonal cell and can be a part of a "word" in the across, up, and down directions.

Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" in the 'across' direction read from left to right.
- "Words" in the 'up' direction read along the upward diagonal to the right.
- "Words" in the 'down' direction read along the downward diagonal to the right.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 2 Mean of 1 down and 8 down
- 4 2 across minus 9 up
- 6 8 up minus 4 across
- 7 Twice the result of 3 up minus 8 up

Up

- 3 8 up plus 4 across
- 5 Three times a prime number
- 8 5 down reversed
- 9 Twice the result of 6 across plus 4 across

Down

- 1 3 up plus 2 across
- 3 2 across minus 7 across
- 5 7 across minus 6 across
- 8 5 down reversed
