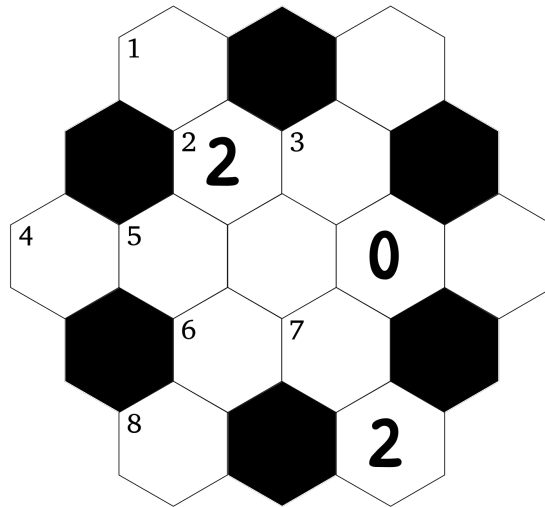
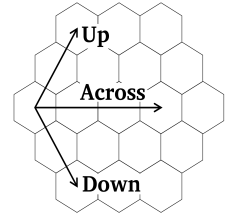


TripleCross - Beginner Puzzle #47

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a hexagonal cell and can be a part of a "word" in the across, up, and down directions.

Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" in the 'across' direction read from left to right.
- "Words" in the 'up' direction read along the upward diagonal to the right.
- "Words" in the 'down' direction read along the downward diagonal to the right.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 2 6 across minus 5 up
- 6 Twice a prime number

Up

- 5 Consecutive digits in ascending order
- 7 Half of 8 up, then subtract 4 across
- 8 Nine thousand sixteen less than 1 down

Down

- 1 Its digits total 2 across
- 3 Five times 5 up
- 5 Half of 2 across

Solution:
