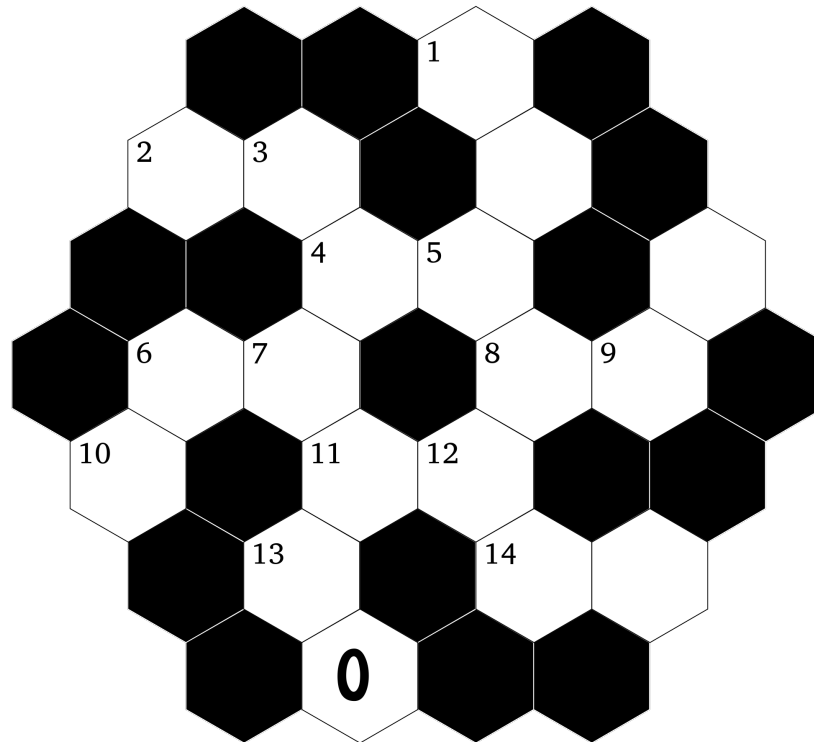
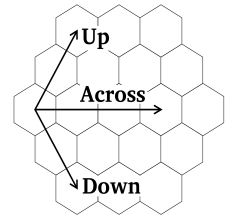


TripleCross - Beginner Puzzle #48

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a hexagonal cell and can be a part of a "word" in the across, up, and down directions.

Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" in the 'across' direction read from left to right.
- "Words" in the 'up' direction read along the upward diagonal to the right.
- "Words" in the 'down' direction read along the downward diagonal to the right.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 2 Mean of 3 down and 14 across
 4 5 up plus 9 up
 6 12 up plus 13 down
 8 Mean of 10 up and 7 down
 11 Twice the result of 4 across minus 12 up
 14 8 across minus 9 up

Up

- 5 8 across minus 13 down
 7 14 across plus 13 down
 9 7 up minus 11 across
 10 2 across reversed
 12 A square
 13 Half of 11 across

Down

- 1 7 up minus 12 down
 3 Mean of 6 across and 7 down
 5 Mean of 8 across and 12 down
 7 A prime number
 12 Mean of 13 down and 5 up
 13 Twice the result of 1 down minus 13 up
