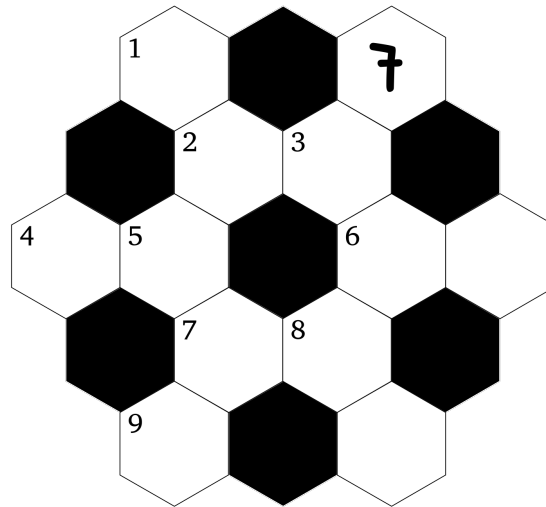
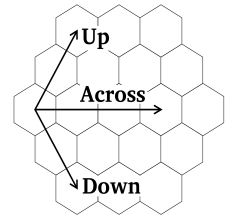


TripleCross - Beginner Puzzle #50

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a hexagonal cell and can be a part of a "word" in the across, up, and down directions.

Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" in the 'across' direction read from left to right.
- "Words" in the 'up' direction read along the upward diagonal to the right.
- "Words" in the 'down' direction read along the downward diagonal to the right.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 2 3 down reversed
- 4 Mean of 7 across and 2 across
- 6 All digits are the same
- 7 Consecutive digits in descending order

Up

- 3 Mean of 5 down and 6 across
- 5 Mean of 3 down and 8 up
- 8 Mean of 8 down and 7 across
- 9 Twice the result of 8 down minus 1 down

Down

- 1 4 across minus 8 up
- 3 Mean of 6 across and 5 up
- 5 Same as 9 up
- 8 Three-fourths of 5 up
