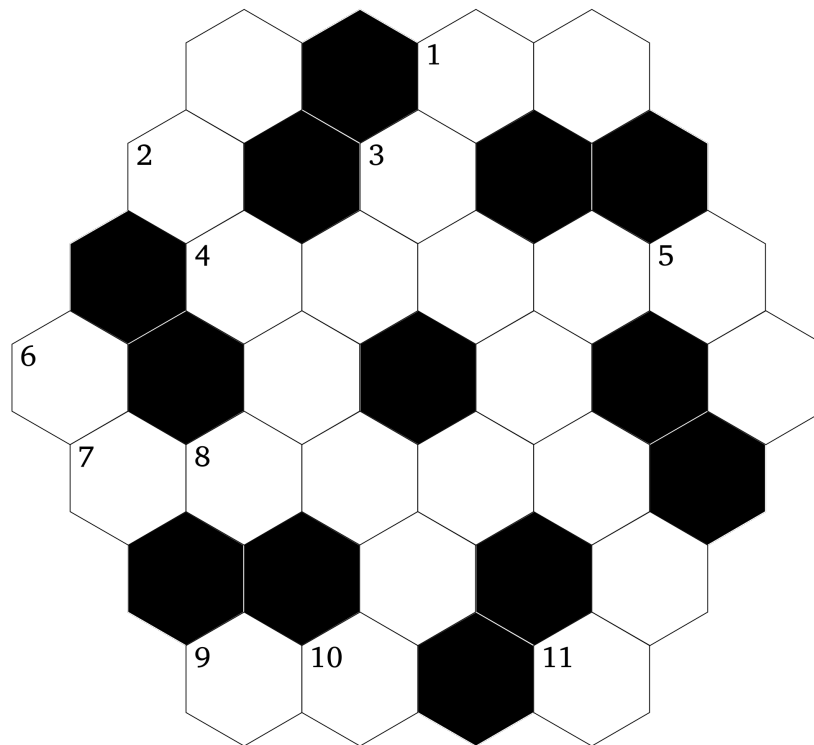
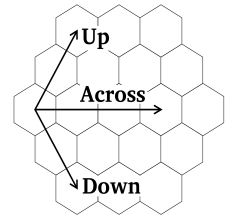


TripleCross - Challenging Puzzle #3

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a hexagonal cell and can be a part of a "word" in the across, up, and down directions.

Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" in the 'across' direction read from left to right.
- "Words" in the 'up' direction read along the upward diagonal to the right.
- "Words" in the 'down' direction read along the downward diagonal to the right.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 1 9 across divided by three
 4 Mean of 2 down and 5 down
 7 Two thousand four hundred seventy-eight less than 2 down
 9 7 across minus 3 down

Up

- 2 A prime number
 10 One thousand nine hundred twenty-four more than 4 across
 11 All digits are the same

Down

- 2 Three times a prime number
 3 Two thousand five hundred sixty-two less than 2 down
 5 All digits are the same
 6 11 up minus 1 across
