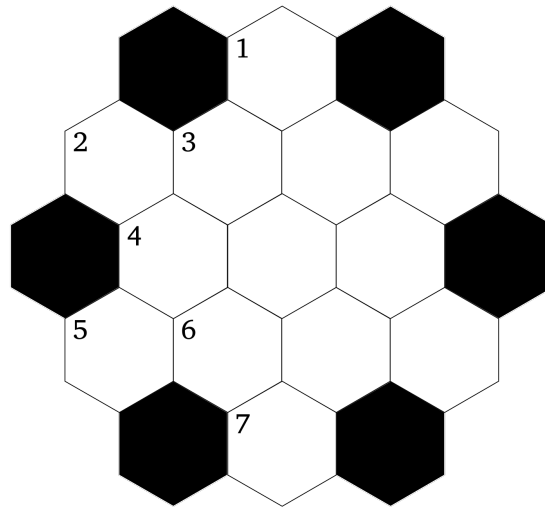
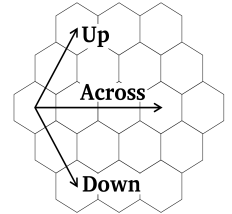


TripleCross - Intermediate Puzzle #5

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a hexagonal cell and can be a part of a "word" in the across, up, and down directions.

Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" in the 'across' direction read from left to right.
- "Words" in the 'up' direction read along the upward diagonal to the right.
- "Words" in the 'down' direction read along the downward diagonal to the right.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 2 Forty-six times a prime number
 4 1 down minus half of 2 across
 5 Ninety-one more than 5 up

Up

- 5 One thousand six hundred seventy-one less than 2 across
 6 Five times a square
 7 Last two digits are the same as last two digits of 5 across

Down

- 1 Twice a prime number
 2 5 across plus 3 down
 3 Last two digits are the same as last two digits of 4 across
