
# TripleCross - Intermediate Puzzle #5

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a hexagonal cell and can be a part of a "word" in the across, up, and down directions.

### **Rules:**

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" in the 'across' direction read from left to right.
- 3. "Words" in the 'up' direction read along the upward diagonal to the right.
- 4. "Words" in the 'down' direction read along the downward diagonal to the right.
- 5. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 6. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



#### Across


- **2** Forty-six times a prime number
- **4** 1 down minus half of 2 across
- **5** Ninety-one more than 5 up

#### Up

- **5** One thousand six hundred seventy-one **1** Twice a prime number less than 2 across
- **6** Five times a square
- 7 Last two digits are the same as last two digits of 5 across

#### Down

- **2** 5 across plus 3 down
- **3** Last two digits are the same as last two digits of 4 across
