
TripleCross - Intermediate Puzzle #17

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a hexagonal cell and can be a part of a "word" in the across, up, and down directions.

Rules:

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" in the 'across' direction read from left to right.
- 3. "Words" in the 'up' direction read along the upward diagonal to the right.
- 4. "Words" in the 'down' direction read along the downward diagonal to the right.
- 5. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 6. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- **1** A square
- **3** 11 down minus 9 down
- **5** Same as 11 down
- 10 Twice the result of 7 down minus 9 down
- **12** 5 across minus 13 up
- 14 11 down plus half of 8 up

Up


4 10 across minus 15 up

- **7** Three times a prime number
- 8 7 down divided by eight
- **9** Mean of 2 down and 1 across **13** 14 across minus 3 across
- **15** 4 up plus 12 across

13 4 up plus 12 across

Down

- **2** Mean of 1 across and 3 across
- **6** Mean of 11 down and 14 across
- 7 Twice 2 down
- 8 15 up divided by four
- **9** 5 across minus 3 across
- 11 12 across plus 13 up
