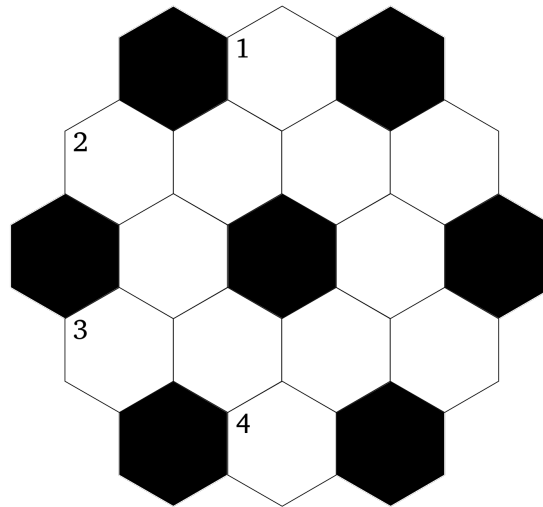


# TripleCross - Intermediate Puzzle #25

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a hexagonal cell and can be a part of a "word" in the across, up, and down directions.

## Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" in the 'across' direction read from left to right.
- "Words" in the 'up' direction read along the upward diagonal to the right.
- "Words" in the 'down' direction read along the downward diagonal to the right.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



### Across

- 2 A prime number
- 3 Twenty-five more than 3 up

### Up

- 3 Forty-seven times a prime number
- 4 Seventy-seven times a prime number

### Down

- 1 Mean of 3 up and 2 across
- 2 Half of 3 across, then subtract 4 up
