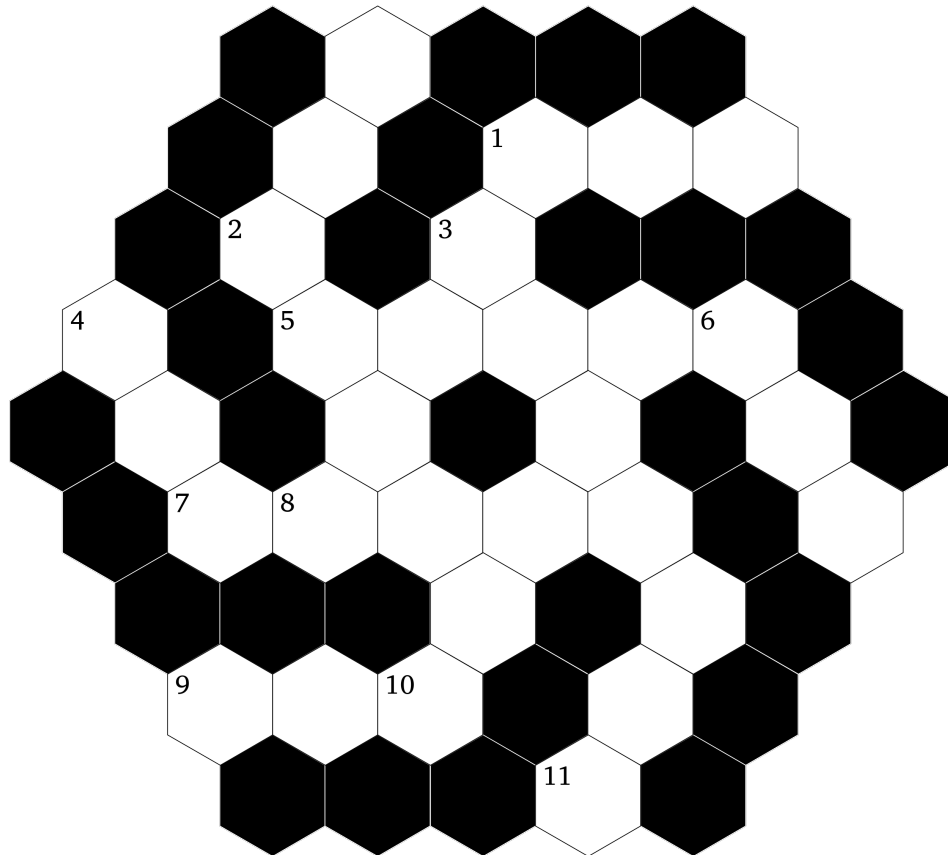
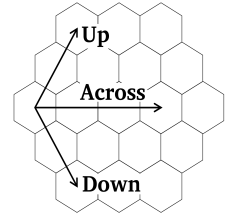


# TripleCross - Intermediate Puzzle #49

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a hexagonal cell and can be a part of a "word" in the across, up, and down directions.

## Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" in the 'across' direction read from left to right.
- "Words" in the 'up' direction read along the upward diagonal to the right.
- "Words" in the 'down' direction read along the downward diagonal to the right.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



## Across

- 1 Two-thirds of 11 up
- 5 Mean of 3 down and 8 up
- 7 Second, fourth, and fifth digits are the same
- 9 Eight more than 1 across

## Up

- 2 Fifty-five times a square
- 8 Twenty thousand one hundred eleven less than 2 down
- 10 Eleven thousand seventy-four more than 5 across
- 11 One hundred ten more than 2 up

## Down

- 2 10 up plus half of 6 down
- 3 Twenty times a prime number
- 4 2 up minus 9 across
- 6 Three times a square
