

# **TripleCross - Intermediate Puzzle #57**

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a hexagonal cell and can be a part of a "word" in the across, up, and down directions.

## **Rules:**

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" in the 'across' direction read from left to right.
- 3. "Words" in the 'up' direction read along the upward diagonal to the right.
- 4. "Words" in the 'down' direction read along the downward diagonal to the right.
- 5. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 6. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



#### Across

- **2** Eighteen times a prime number
- **4** Thirty times a prime number
- 5 7 up minus 6 up

## Up

- **5** Nine times a prime number
- **6** One hundred seventy-two less than 1 down
- **7** Seven hundred fifty-one more than 5 up

#### **Down**

- 1 3 down plus half of 4 across
- 2 Nine hundred sixty-seven less than 5 up
- **3** Three times a prime number
