



TripleCross - Intermediate Puzzle #78

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a hexagonal cell and can be a part of a "word" in the across, up, and down directions.

Rules:

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" in the 'across' direction read from left to right.
- 3. "Words" in the 'up' direction read along the upward diagonal to the right.
- 4. "Words" in the 'down' direction read along the downward diagonal to the right.
- 5. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 6. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.





Across

- 2 All digits are the same
- **4** A prime number
- **6** Six times a prime number
- **9** A cube
- 11 10 up minus half of 5 down

Up

- **1** A square
- **7** 9 across minus 7 down
- **10** Consecutive digits in ascending order **5** 13 up plus 11 across
- **12** A prime number
- 13 1 up plus 2 across

Down

- 1 Half of 6 across, then subtract 8 down
- **3** A prime number
- 7 4 across minus 3 down
- 8 A square
